ELIGIBILITY

This contest is open to all students in grades K-12 (as of Fall 2023) who attend a CVUSD or DSUSD school in Indio

THEME

Put Waste in its Place! The contest is funded by a Clean California grant, a statewide program created to beautify and clean up local streets and roads, tribal lands, parks, pathways, transit centers and other public spaces. Posters can depict the effects of litter, how to properly dispose of waste or the artist's feelings toward littering.

PRIZES

- ▶ Four (4) winners will be selected from each of three seasonal themes (winter, spring/summer, and fall).
- ▶ The 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th place winners from each group will receive CASH PRIZES of \$100, \$75, \$50 and \$25 respectively.
- ▶ All winners will have their artwork included in the 2023-2024 City of Indio Sustainability calendar.
- ▶ Winners will be announced on Thursday, September 7, 2023.

GUIDELINES

- ▶ Phrases and words are allowed but should be limited.
- ▶ Poster size must be NO LARGER than 12-by-18 inches.
- ▶ Clearly indicate the student's full name, grade, and school.
- ▶ Artwork must be original; copyrighted material will not be accepted.
- ▶ Materials used may include but are not limited to crayons, watercolor, poster paint, markers, ink, pastels, chalk, cut out paper, fabric, colored pencils.
- ▶ Parent/guardian signature acknowledges that any submission becomes the property of the City of Indio for reproduction/promotional purposes.

PREMIOS

- ▶ Se seleccionarán cuatro (4) ganadores de cada uno de los tres temas de temporada (invierno, primavera/verano y otoño).
- ▶ Los ganadores del 1.º, 2.º, 3.º y 4.º lugar de cada grupo recibirán PREMIOS EN EFECTIVO de \$100, \$75, \$50 y \$25 respectivamente.
- ▶ La obra de arte de todos los ganadores se incluirá en el calendario de sostenibilidad de la ciudad de Indio 2023-2024.
- ▶ Los ganadores se anunciarán el jueves, 7 de septiembre de 2023.

- ▶ La obra de arte debe ser original; no se aceptará material con derechos de autor.
- ▶ Los materiales utilizados pueden incluir, entre otros, crayones, acuarela, pintura para carteles, marcadores, tinta, pasteles, tiza, papel recortado, tela, lápices de colores.
